Please remember to stay safe over the holiday time.

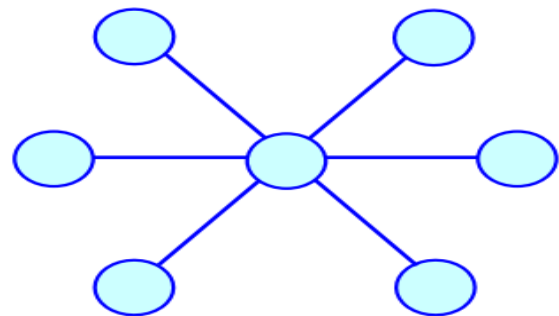
Children need to remember all the things they've learnt in school about keeping themselves safe. Particularly around rail way lines as we've been informed that the cross city line has now been electrified.
